

LeDeR is about doing reviews on the lives and deaths of people with a learning disability and autistic people so we can make health and care better.



The reviewer finds out about the person's care and why they died.



LeDeR has found that people with a learning disability and autistic people do not always get good healthcare.

Sometimes people with a learning disability and autistic people die younger than other people.



Good healthcare might have stopped people with a learning disability and autistic people from getting very unwell or dying too young.



If you have a disability, there should be a **flag** on your health and care record.




A **flag** is a note on your health record which tells health and care staff to look at your records for more information.



The **flag** tells health and care staff which **reasonable adjustments** you need.

A **reasonable adjustment** is a change that a service should make, to support someone with a disability.



Reasonable adjustments support people to get good, person-centred health and care.



Person-centred means putting you first, caring about what you want and listening to your choices so that your support needs are met, if possible.




In the future, a **reasonable adjustment digital flag** will be used by **all** health and care services paid for by the NHS or local councils.



Health and care staff can see the reasonable adjustments you need and share this information, this includes your hospital and your GP (doctor).

A health and care passport is a document that is a quick and easy way to tell health and care staff more information about you.



In **2024** we gave **integrated care systems** some new guidance.



Integrated care systems are health and care organisations working together to provide services and make plans.



The NHS in this part of the country found new ways to look after children with breathing problems.



The team also showed parents how to do physiotherapy with their children to keep them well.



They made a care plan for each child.




The plan says everything that the person needs to keep them healthy and to look after their lungs and the airways that they breathe through.

Good health groups make sure that people with a learning disability can get the right support in the area they live.



They employed more staff to support people with a learning disability.




LeDeR resource bank
